

3G rule in the workplace



The 3G rule in the workplace will enter into force on 1 November. If physical contact with other people in the workplace cannot be ruled out, proof of vaccination, recovery or testing will be required in the future. A transitional period applies until 14 November (including): a **person who does not have a 3G proof must wear an FFP2 mask at all times.**

Who will have to provide evidence in the future?

If physical contact with customers or colleagues cannot be ruled out, whether it is a business office, workshop, office of an authority, hairdresser or shop – employees must have a 3G certificate. Exceptions apply to jobs such as truck drivers or

night watchmen with very short contacts, and a home office.

Antigen and PCR tests are allowed – **antigen tests are valid for 24 hours, PCR tests for 72 hours.**

Who inspect 3G documents?

Employers and employees are responsible for complying with the measures. Employers are responsible for inspections. Inspections should be carried out at random. **Employees face administrative fines of up to EUR 500, employers of up to EUR 3,600.**
